In-network vs. Out-of-network

“In-network” dental providers have contracted with Delta Dental to accept certain negotiated (discounted) rates. You will typically pay less with an in-network provider because Delta Dental cannot hold “out-of-network” providers to specific, pre-negotiated rates for services like they can with an in-network provider.

Delta Dental PPO vs. Premier: What’s the Difference?

There are two types of in-network dentists: Preferred Provider Organization (PPO) and Premier. These are dentists with whom Delta Dental has a contract, and as a rule involves less out-of-pocket contribution from the patient. Plan details vary for each group, many groups have “Active PPO” which means they’ll have stronger benefit levels if seen by a PPO provider. Others may have “Passive PPO” which means in-network benefits are paid at the same percentages as benefits paid for out-of-network care.
